New Requirement Effective July 19 – FAQs

To get more clients on their way to a faster, more convenient buying experience, beginning July 19, 2021, all PruFast Track eligible business MUST be submitted via Prudential Xpress QuickForm worksheet or Drop Ticket.

What cases are eligible for PruFast Track?

- Age: 18 to 60
- Face Amounts: \$100,000 to \$3,000,000
- Quoted Underwriting Category: Smoker or better
- U.S. Residents
- Products: Most of Prudential's Term and Permanent Products (excludes PruTerm One and Survivorship products)

What application types are eligible for PruFast Track?

How can I access the Worksheet?

The worksheet is available as a fillable PDF and as an iGO eApp on PruXpress.com. General Agencies with an iPipeline account may also have a link to the iGO eApp version on their website. Other forms engines that carry the Worksheet include Paperless Solutions Group, IXN, and VitalForms.

How can I access a Drop Ticket?

The General Agency website may include links to iPipeline for Fast App and/or ApplicInt's ExpressComplete ticket. A Fast App link is also available at PruXpress.com. Please note that if the Fast App ticket is started through PruXpress.com, the case will be submitted directly to Prudential and will not include a GA stop.

Can I still submit a long application if I want to avoid accelerated underwriting?

No, all eligible cases must be submitted via Worksheet or Drop Ticket.

What if I have a long application that was started before July 19? Can I still submit it?

We recommend switching to Worksheet or Drop Ticket as soon as possible. If you have a long application that was already started and we receive it on or after July 19, we will process the application and provide feedback regarding the missed opportunity.

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
